

The evening began with Lindsay introducing Sean, with a short summary of his background. Sean began with a short video of his study in Japan carving an ume.




Tamarisk Dig February 11-12, Location: Sunset Ranch Oasis, Mecca Ca, Time: 10:00am Saturday to 4:00pm Sunday

Look at the website for pictures: www.sunsetranchoasis.com. It takes about an hour and 45 minutes from Monrovia to get to the Ranch (210 to the 10) - it is in Mecca in the East end of the Coachella Valley. Tamarisk roots easily in water, or the plant can be dug out of the ground. The web site shows the nice area around the house and fishing lake (bass, catfish and bluegill), and there is a lot of Tamarisk covered land on the rest of the property. Please let Tom know ASAP if you want to go either for the day or overnight.

Baikoen Bonsai Kenkyukai will be conducting a Tamarisk Dig in February 2017. The excursion will span Saturday February 11 to Sunday February 12, 2017 at the Sunset Ranch Oasis. Which means you can come either day or dig both days and stay overnight! Tamarisk digging or cutting or chain sawing is the easiest collection yamadori species possible in Southern California. Please take this opportunity seriously, because you might not know when the next dig might occur! Overnight stay will be limited to 20 total spots including non-diggers so please email or text me (Tom Lau) ASAP if you like to stay overnight. If you just like to dig Saturday or Sunday, please also forward any communication to me (Tom Lau) ASAP so I can better coordinate the details out. Well I hope to hear from some of you soon!
